\*\*\*Contact information is **required** for the authorized adult who will be the academic coordinator for students that will be participating in the academic testing or composition for Nationals. All academic information will be communicated to this person, including testing window, access to the tests, and tie-breaker testing (if needed); therefore, the academic coordinator **must** be able to contact students whether testing is done at the school or on-site at Nationals, particularly during tie-breaker testing April 11, 10:45 a.m.–4:00 p.m. EST. (Hawaii and Guam schools will receive separate instructions.) If no students from the school are involved in testing or composition, this information is not required.

<b>Number of Non-Residence Hall Students*</b> (listed on student forms)  *Contestants may stay in residence halls or in local hotels. (Due to the limited number of beds, contestants living within 50 miles of Greenville may not stay in residence halls.) Residence hall housing can be reserved on a first-come, first-served basis, by completing the 2019 AACS National Competition Student Residence Hall Form. Anyone staying in the Greenville area (local residents, hotel, or on-campus) is required to attend <b>both</b> chapel and evening service <b>every</b> day. Anyone over 50 miles who drives instead of staying in Greenville must attend one service each day [either chapel (11:00 a.m.) or evening service (7:00 p.m.)]. The Tuesday p.m. service and sponsor meeting are required for <b>all</b> .		
<b>Number of Art/Testing/Composition Competitors not coming to the event</b> (listed on back)  If an art or academic competitor is not coming to BJU, don't list him or her on any housing forms.		
<b>Number of Residence Hall Sponsors**</b> (listed on sponsor forms)  **Male and female sponsors must be provided to stay in the residence hall with their group. Schools are required to provide one sponsor to stay in a residence hall for each group of 24 students in the residence hall. For example: 1–24 boys = 1 male sponsor      25–49 boys = 2 male sponsors      50–74 boys = 3 male sponsors 1–24 girls = 1 female sponsor      25–49 girls = 2 female sponsors      50–74 girls = 3 female sponsors If the sponsor has not yet been selected, on the sponsor registration form please list "female (or male) sponsor TBD" so that a place is held for the sponsor. The school must notify AACS of the name of the sponsor by March 29, 2019. We regret that due to limited space in the residence halls additional sponsors above the requirement must make off-campus housing arrangements.
